- Started at RG in all 17 games, blocking for an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per game (424.9), yards per play (6.8 third-best single-season mark in NFL history) and red zone efficiency (74.2%) and No. 3 in points per game (30.5), while setting a franchise single-season record with 7,224 net yards...Baltimore's rushing attack also averaged an NFL-best 187.6 yards per game and 5.8 yards per carry (best figure in single-season NFL history)
