— KEY TRANSACTIONS —

- Signed a three-year contract extension (through 2024) with the Ravens on 12/30/21
- Signed by the Ravens as a rookie free agent on 5/3/19...Was one of two (OLB Otarso Alata) undrafted RFAs to make the Ravens' Week 1 53-man roster

— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Started in all 17 games across the Ravens' O-Line in 2024, blocking for an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per game (424.9), yards per play (6.8 – third-best single-season mark in NFL history) and red zone efficiency (74.2%) and No. 3 in points per game (30.5), while setting a franchise single-season record with 7,224 net yards...Baltimore's rushing attack also averaged an NFL-best 187.6 yards per game and 5.8 yards per carry (best figure in single-season NFL history)
- With the nod at LG in the 35-10 win vs. Buf. (9/29/24), a game in which the offense totaled 427 yards (271 rushing and 156 passing) and 5 TDs, has started at all five spots on the offensive line throughout his career
- Appeared in 17 games (seven starts) with Baltimore in 2023, helping block for the NFL's No. 1 rushing offense (156.6 ypg) and No. 4 scoring offense (28.4 ppg)...The ground game eclipsed 100 yards in all 17 contests, while also setting a single-season franchise record with 26 rushing TDs
- In 2021, saw action in 13 games (12 starts) at RT, blocking for the NFL's sixth-ranked offense (378.8 ypg) and third-best rushing attack (145.8 ypg)
- Helped block for a Ravens rushing attack that topped 100 yards in 43 straight games (2018-21), tying for the longest streak of its kind in NFL history (Pittsburgh – 1974-77)
- In 2020, saw action in all 14 games (eight starts), seeing time at RG and center...Helped block for the NFL's No. 1 rushing attack (191.9 ypg), which produced the third-most yards (3,071) ever in a 16-game NFL season...Baltimore owned the seventh-best scoring offense (29.3 ppg) and fourth-best third-down offense (48.8%)...The Ravens also tallied a then-franchise-record 24 rushing TDs
- Started at RG and helped block for a rushing attack that totaled 110 ground yards and 2 TDs in the 24-10 win at Ind. (11/8/20)...Baltimore scored 17 unanswered in the second half to capture the victory and set an NFL record with its 31st-straight game scoring at least 20 points
- In 2019, helped the Ravens set new single-season franchise records for total TDs (64), points (531), rushing yards (3,296) and total net yards (6,521)...The Ravens also became the first team in league history to average at least 200 rushing (206.0) and 200 net passing (201.6) yards per game in a season

— PERSONAL —

- Both of Mekari's parents fled war-torn countries in the Middle East in the 1970s and immigrated to Los Angeles – his mother left Iran and his father is from Lebanon
- While at Cal, played with his older brother, Tony, who was a defensive lineman and law student at UC Davis

— 2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS —

- Started in all 17 games across the Ravens' O-Line, blocking for an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per game (424.9), yards per play (6.8 – third-best single-season mark in NFL history) and red zone efficiency (74.2%) and No. 3 in points per game (30.5), while setting a franchise single-season record with 7,224 net yards...Baltimore's rushing attack also averaged an NFL-best 187.6 yards per game and 5.8 yards per carry (best figure in single-season NFL history)
- Started at LG, helping block for an offense that totaled 464 yards (third most in franchise playoff history), including a franchise playoff-record 299 rushing yards, in the 28-14 Wild Card win vs. Pit. (1/11/25)...The Ravens were 10-of-15 (66.7%) on third down, marking the franchise's best single-game playoff figure ever
- Started at LG, helping block for an offense that totaled 437 yards (217 passing & 220 rushing) and 4 TDs in the 35-10 win vs. Cle. (1/4)...Baltimore's rushing attack averaged 6.3 yards per carry, marking their 14th time recording at least 5.0 yards per carry in a game this season, a new franchise record
- Started at LG, blocking for an offense that totaled 432 yards (181 passing & 251 rushing) and scored a TD on all three red zone drives in the 31-2 win at Hou. (12/25)...Helped Baltimore reach over 400 yards of total offense for a franchise-record ninth time on the season...Baltimore also averaged at least 7 yards per play for the seventh time on the season, tying (SF in 2023 and NO in 2011) for the most-such games in NFL single-season history
- Started at LG, blocking for an offense that totaled 418 yards (198 passing & 220 rushing) in the 34-17 win vs. Pit. (12/21)...Helped Baltimore become the first team in NFL history to register at least 3,500 passing yards and 2,500 rushing yards through the first 15 games of a season...The Ravens tallied at least 30 points for a franchise-record ninth time on the season
- Started at LG, helping block for an offense that totaled 445 yards (275 passing & 170 rushing) and 5 TDs in the 35-14 win at NYG (12/15)...Baltimore converted on 9-of-11 third-down attempts, marking a season-best 81.8% success rate

- Blocked for an offense that totaled 30 points and 389 yards (177 passing & 212 rushing), while reaching the end zone on 2-of-2 red zone opportunities and moving the chains on 8-of-15 (53%) third downs and 3-of-3 (100%) fourth-and-1 attempts, in the MNF win at LAC (11/25)
- Started at LG, blocking for an offense that tallied 5 TDs in the 41-10 win vs. Den. (11/3)...Baltimore's 14.2 yards gained per pass attempt (269 yards on 19 attempts) was the third-best mark in single-game franchise history...Helped QB Lamar Jackson set an NFL record with his fourth-career game with a perfect 158.3 passer rating (min. 15 attempts each game)
- Started at LG, helping block for an offense that totaled 484 yards (308 passing & 176 rushing) and 3 TDs in the 30-23 win vs. Was. (10/13)...Baltimore registered an NFL-record sixth-straight game with at least 150 yards and 1 TD each through the air and on the ground
- Started at LG, helping block for an offense that totaled 520 (345 passing & 175 rushing) yards, converted 10-of-15 (66.7%) third-down attempts and reached the end zone on 5-of-6 (83.3%) red zone drives, en route to the 41-38 OT win at Cin. (10/6)...Baltimore's 520 total yards marked the seventh most in franchise history...The Ravens also became the fifth team since 1980 with at least 1,000 rushing yards through their first five games of a season
- Started at LG, blocking for an offense that totaled 427 yards (271 rushing and 156 passing) and 5 TDs in the 35-10 win vs. Buf. (9/29)...Baltimore's 7.97 yards per carry ranked as the third-best mark in single-game franchise history (8.79 vs. NYG in 2022 and 8.37 vs. Cle. in 2003)...With the nod at LG, has now started at all five spots on the offensive line throughout his career
- Started at RT, helping block for an offense that totaled 456 yards (274 rushing and 182 passing) and 4 TDs in the 28-25 win at Dal. (9/22)...Baltimore's 274-yard rushing output marked the 10th-most rushing yards in single-game franchise history...Also contributed to a line that didn't permit a sack
- Started at RT, blocking for an offense that produced 452 total yards (185 rushing & 267 passing) and 5.8 yards per carry at KC (9/5)
