## — COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS —

- Appeared in 31 games (19 starts), primarily at RT, during his four-year career (2020-23) at Washington...Helped the team attain a 14-1 mark (undefeated in the regular season), win the Pac-12 Championship and reach the College Football National Championship in his final season (2023)
- Blocked for left-handed QB Michael Penix Jr. (2022-23), serving as the blindside protector for the 2023 Maxwell Award Winner (which is presented to the best player in college football), 2023 Heisman Trophy finalist and 2022 *AP* Comeback Player of the Year
- Never gave up a sack during his collegiate career

## — PERSONAL —

- Was a two-sport athlete (football and basketball) at Valor Christian...Also played baseball as a kid
- Worked out in the concourse of Husky Stadium when the team was unable to use the locker room and practice field before the 2020 season due to COVID restrictions
- Moved to RT his last two years at UW to protect left-handed QB Michael Penix Jr.'s blindside
- Ran the fastest 40-yard dash of any offensive lineman at the 2024 Combine (4.92)
- Played basketball, soccer, baseball and flag football before he took up football...The summer before high school, his baseball team made it to the Colorado USSSA state championship game...Coached by former Denver Broncos Ben Hamilton and Tyler Polumbus in high school

## — 2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS —

- Blocked for an offense that totaled 30 points and 389 yards (177 passing & 212 rushing), while reaching the end zone on 2-of-2 red zone opportunities and moving the chains on 8-of-15 (53%) third downs and 3-of-3 (100%) fourth-and-1 attempts, in the MNF win at LAC (11/25)
- Started at RT, blocking for an offense that tallied 5 TDs in the 41-10 win vs. Den. (11/3)...Baltimore's 14.2 yards gained per pass attempt (269 yards on 19 attempts) was the third-best mark in single-game franchise history...Helped QB Lamar Jackson set an NFL record with his fourth-career game with a perfect 158.3 passer rating (min. 15 attempts each game)
- Started at RT, blocking for an offense that totaled 508 yards (ninth-best single-game output in franchise history) and 5 TDs in the 41-31 win at TB (10/21)...Baltimore's 9.4 yards per play marked a franchise record...The Ravens also averaged 8.1 yards per rush, good for the third-highest mark in single-game franchise history
- Started at RT, helping block for an offense that totaled 484 yards (308 passing & 176 rushing) and 3 TDs in the 30-23 win vs. Was. (10/13)...Baltimore registered an NFL-record sixth-straight game with at least 150 yards and 1 TD each through the air and on the ground
- Started at RT, helping block for an offense that totaled 520 (345 passing & 175 rushing) yards, converted 10-of-15 (66.7%) third-down attempts and reached the end zone on 5-of-6 (83.3%) red zone drives, en route to the 41-38 OT win at Cin. (10/6)...Baltimore's 520 total yards marked the seventh most in franchise history...The Ravens also became the fifth team since 1980 with at least 1,000 rushing yards through their first five games of a season
- Made his first career start at RT, blocking for an offense that totaled 427 yards (271 rushing and 156 passing) and 5 TDs in the 35-10 win vs. Buf. (9/29)...Baltimore's 7.97 yards per carry ranked as the third-best mark in single-game franchise history (8.79 vs. NYG in 2022 and 8.37 vs. Cle. in 2003)
- Made his NFL debut at KC (9/5), playing 20 snaps on offense, while adding 5 ST snaps...Helped Baltimore total 452 yards (185 rushing & 267 passing) and 5.8 yards per carry
