- Started all 11 games in which he saw action in 2022, helping block for the NFL's No. 2 rush offense (160.2 ypg), which produced the league's most rushes (88) of 10+ yards and most games (12) with 150+ rushing yards
- Helped block for a Ravens rushing attack that topped 100 rushing yards in 43 consecutive games (2018-21), tying for the longest streak of its kind in NFL history (Pit. – 1974-77)

- Started at LT in all 17 games, blocking for an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per game (424.9), yards per play (6.8 third-best single-season mark in NFL history) and red zone efficiency (74.2%) and No. 3 in points per game (30.5), while setting a franchise single-season record with 7,224 net yards...Baltimore's rushing attack also averaged an NFL-best 187.6 yards per game and 5.8 yards per carry (best figure in single-season NFL history)
